Please make these changes as soon as possible:

- 2) Add the events that are not listed (PNW) & the correct dates and links.
- 3) Add a button that says "Sponsor an Event!" and link it to the 2 page flyer you did. (Put up the one with the last 3 events for now. As soon as you get the 2012-13 one complete, we can add that one.) Add the Ad Reps email links for folks to contact us for information.
- 4) Add links at the bottom that will link to the "Thank You" Sponsor ad for past events.

If you can add some pictures or a link to the Facebook pics of these events (especially ones with sponsors in them!), that would be a nice enhancement.
