Some thoughts on the regatta/rally/fleet concept. I know it would be down the road a bit when we're back in fighting form.

FL to Mex:

That FL to Mex route can be rough, not ideal for charter boats (skippers I'm worried about). When Cuba opens up we'll jump on it and get a couple stops there - own the new market. Lats restaurant in Cuba? I want to be part of that. Again, for the Lats part we can charter out of Belize and meet a cruiser's rally coming from FL/TX at El Cid. There are a lot of boats heading to cruise Belize, Honduras, Guatemala etc. After the party we could sail the fleet back toward Belize and drop off the boats. Three weeks round trip, two share the sails, bi-annual event?

I know it doesn't incorporate El Cid but there's another option for a FL to el Carib regatta. Do a regatta with charter boats and sail-along cruisers from FL to Puerto Rico through paradise - Bahamas and Turks and Caicos. I have a friend with a marina in Puerto Rico. US to US, it's pretty clean.

Again, down and back, 20 days, two share the sails, pre season, boats out of Bahamas?
